



Emery School District Emergency Connectivity Fund Program Agreement

Emery School District is providing _____ (Student name) with a Chromebook, upon recommendation from a school district administrator, as an assistive technology device to meet educational needs. Emery School District is not responsible for monitoring, or liable for misuse of the device while being used off

Emery School District property.

Expected responsible behaviors to use this device:

Students must comply with the Acceptable Use policy of Emery School District.

Parent (Guardian) must comply with Acceptable Use policy of Emery School District

Parent (Guardian) and student must sign and return this Student Device Responsible Use Contract before the Chromebook can be issued to the student.

RESPONSIBLE USE EXPECTATIONS

- All aspects of the district's acceptable use policy for technology apply when using the device.
- Parents/guardians are responsible for filtering home internet access.
- Devices will run through our cloud filtering meeting CIPA law, the student will not try and bypass this filter using the device.
- Parents/guardians agree to supervise Chromebook use at home and agree to discuss Internet safety with their child.
- Once issued, the student is responsible for taking excellent care and caution in the protection, care and use of the device.
- If a device malfunctions or needs repair, the student will not attempt repair but will return it to Emery School District for repair.
- The student is responsible for any damage that occurs while the device is off district premises. If the device is damaged the student will not be issued another device.
- Internet games are not allowed on the Chromebook without teacher approval and supervision
- All software/apps will only be installed by the District's Technology Department and only software and apps that support the District's curricular goals will be installed.
- The Chromebook is Emery School District property and may be inspected by district staff at any time.
- Reasons for Chromebook inspections may include but are not limited to the following: functionality, maintenance, service, and violations of the student acceptable use policy.
- Cyberbullying will not be tolerated. Cyberbullying is bullying by use of any device, including the Chromebook. Messages and/or internet content relating to or in support of illegal activities will be reported to legal authorities.
- The student is expected to notify adults of any messages or information that is inappropriate, dangerous, or threatening.
- The student will not lend the Chromebook to anyone for any reason.

GENERAL USAGE PRACTICES

- In the event there is damage, theft, or loss of a Chromebook the student must contact Emery District staff immediately. The student will not be issued another device.
- All reports of vandalism or misuse of the device will be investigated on a case-by-case basis.
- The students are prohibited from attempting to bypass the district filter.
- Student withdrawal, expulsion or transfer of enrollment from the Emery School District, or for any other reason, must return the Chromebook, and all district provided peripherals on the date of termination.
- The Chromebook will be returned when the District feels the Chromebook is no longer a necessity for the students' education.
- Presence of weapons, pornographic materials, inappropriate language, or inappropriate images (ex. drugs, alcohol) is not allowed on the device and will result in disciplinary actions.
- Conduct yourself in a socially acceptable and positive manner when using the device, the network, and the internet.
- Do not download, copy, or share copyrighted material. This includes music files, images, or software.
- Chromebook must never be left in any unsupervised area.

STUDENT/GUARDIAN ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

- The student understands that the use of the Chromebook is a privilege, not a right, and is for educational purposes.
- The student/guardian understands the device is part of a grant and the district can not issue another device to a student.
- The District may revoke the student's use of the Chromebook at any time, and acceptable alternatives will be discussed with the principal.
- Violation of this agreement or District policies/procedures may result in disciplinary action.
- The student has no expectation of privacy in the contents of the Chromebook or communications made using the Chromebook.
- The student understands that the District may filter or block any material that the District deems to be inappropriate. The Student understands that such filters or blocks may restrict access to certain Internet sites.
- The student and the parents/guardians authorize the District to retain any of the student's emails that constitute student records under the Utah Student Records Act and the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).
- The student and the parents/guardians understand that the District's issuance of the Chromebook does not create any duty on the part of the District to provide digital supervision or protection outside of school.
- The student and the parents/guardians release the District from liability for activities undertaken on the Chromebook outside of school or not related to school work.
- The Chromebook will be checked periodically for damages. If a device is lost or damaged and cannot be used or repaired, the student will be responsible for the full replacement cost, or will not be issued another Chromebook for the duration of their education.
